

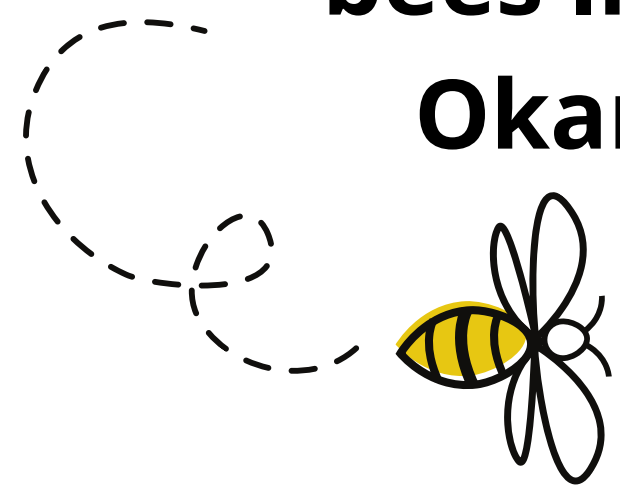
# BIODIVERSITY SCAVENGER HUNT

The \_\_\_\_\_, a region’s climate, soils, and terrain, is greatly affected by biodiversity and creates better wine!

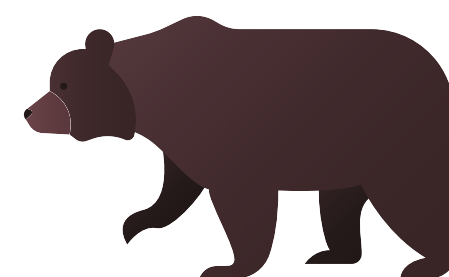
## EXPLORE

Take a picture, or draw, three wild animals you may see around the Okanagan.

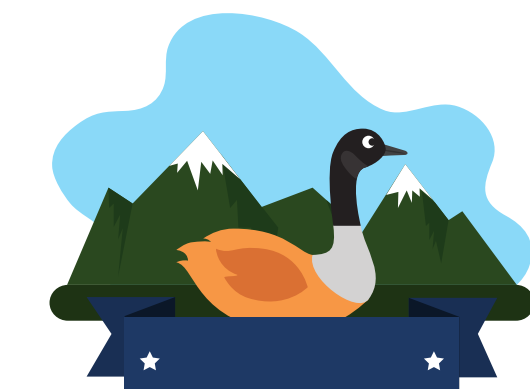
Track some of your bird sightings using a bird watching app like eBird.
